With the venue reserved for you for 2 hours and entrance denied to visitors, you will be guaranteed all the privacy you require for your ceremony, beautifully set up amongst exotic shrubs in the courtyard. Tell us what your colour scheme is, add any extra decorations you may wish and all will be organised for you. Music can be played and you may supply your own playlist in advance (live music, violinist, harpist, etc can be arranged at a supplement). Another lovely, traditional touch is that confetti are permitted.

### Cocktail Parties & Wedding Receptions

Drinks and canapes (for up to 90 persons standing) can be arranged and served on-site after the ceremony. A barbecue buffet could take place if your party is of at least 20 persons and in this instance the venue would be reserved exclusively for you for a total of 5 hours (maximum 50 persons seated).
